- The Policy Committee has developed health care policy recommendations that will be communicated to OPM to advance LGBTQIA+ employees. The six recommendations are:
 - 1. Reduce barriers to preauthorization
 - 2. Reduce barriers to care networks
 - 3. Reduce barriers to claim appeals
 - 4. Ensure consistent coverage of comprehensive gender affirming care
 - 5. Promote access to quality sexual health
 - 6. Promote access to family building benefits and services for LGBTQIA+ federal employees
